




Historic and Current Total Enrollment*


Resident Enrollment*




Resident Rolling Average*







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Baseline Enrollment Projection Method

Weighted Survival


Projects grade by grade enrollment based on historical survival ratios (percent continuing) with a greater weight given to the most recent years

Reflects current student population with an allowance for additional resident enrollment at specific grade levels

Fine-Tuning process includes review of current, point in time enrollment to ensure any out of the ordinary changes are accounted for




Baseline Projection






Total Projected Enrollment

Special Education Projections

Open Enrollment Recommendation for Special Education:

- Considering all factors for projections, all program areas across the district do not have space for any students with disabilities from other districts with special education needs.
- Therefore, it is recommended that no spaces be opened for students with special education needs. This includes all Cross-Categorical, Speech and Language, Occupational Therapy and Specially Designed Physical Education.
 Program areas that we contract services for are also not eligible for space
