General Information

1. We are unable to escort your child to and from programs due to the staffing needs that this service would require. There will be a pick-up time from 12:00 - 12:30 pm for those who choose not to stay for the whole day. However, please note that the fee reflects an all day, weekly registration.
2. Please be respectful of our pickup and drop off times. We set these to correspond with our planned activities. If you need flexibility with pick up or drop off, please inform supervisors immediately.
3. The following procedure will be in effect if disruptive behavior occurs:
 - a. Verbal contact between camp supervisors and program participant
 - b. Verbal contact and written documentation between the Recreation Department and participant's parent/guardian.
 - c. Removal from the program if behavior continues.
4. For Camp Shorewood, no refund, class transfer, or credit will be granted after Tuesday, June 11th, 2024. All registration additions must be completed by 12 noon the Tuesday prior to the week of camp, provided there is availability.
5. We will still hold camp when there is inclement weather, we will modify and adjust our day as needed. Please plan accordingly for weather, we will walk children to activities rain or shine. However, other recreation programs might be canceled (i.e., tennis lessons). Any questions about weather cancellations, please contact the Recreation Office directly.
6. Our camp is open to children aged 4 - 11, (*Students must be at least 4 years old by March 31, 2024, to participate*). We will split into groups by age to allow for the most effective form of play and socialization.

7. Every day, please send your child in their swimsuit, towel, water bottle, snacks, lunch, extra clothes, active shoes, spray sunscreen and socks for bowling days. On Tuesday and Thursdays (swim lesson day) please send your child dressed in their swimsuit.
8. We ask parents to limit toys being brought to camp. We will have plenty of toys and activities for your child. We are not responsible for any misplaced items that are brought to camp.
9. Please be as informative as possible on your *Child Information Form*. We want to make your child's experience at camp the best it can be! Please share with us any allergies, emergency contacts, IEP information, etc. The more we know, the better our staff can help.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. Where is drop off and pick up?

Drop off and pick up will take place at Lake Bluff cafetorium. You can park in the staff parking lot and enter through the back door.

Do I need to sign my child in and out?

Yes, we require a parent or an authorized person(s) to sign their child in and out each day. Unless written permission is given by parent/guardian for the child to sign themselves in and out of Camp Shorewood.

2. If I drop my child off directly at their summer school class, will you pick them up?

Yes, a counselor from our staff will meet the children at the front of Lake Bluff School following their last class.

3. If my child is going to be absent, do I need to notify the Recreation Department?

Notice of absence is not necessary. Please note refunds and make-ups are not given due to an absence.

4. Who should I call if I need to contact my child during camp?

5. What is the child to staff ratio for Camp Shorewood?

Grades entering K4 - K5 ratio is 1:6

Grades entering 1 - 2 ratio is 1:8

Grades entering 3 - 6 ratio is 1:10
