WI State Assessment System



Grades & Subjects Assessed

- WI Forward (Elementary & Middle School)
 - Designed to evaluate how well students are mastering the Wisconsin Academic Standards
 - Grades 3-8: English language arts (ELA) and mathematics
 - Grades 4 & 8: Science
 - Grades 4, 8, and 10: Social Studies

ACT Aspire (High School)

- Grade 9 & 10: Summative assessment aligned to the ACT and the ACT College and Career Readiness Standards
- Measures what students have learned in the areas of English,
 Reading, Mathematics, and Science

ACT (High School)

Grade 11: Reading, Math, English, Science, Writing



WI Student Assessment System Timelines

Spring

March/April Testing Window for WI Forward,
 ACT Aspire and ACT

Summer

Districts receive data for analysis

Fall

 Districts share individual, school, & district data with community

History & Context

- Began in Spring 2016 no WI Forward exams given in Spring 2020
- 2. Spring 2021 Forward Exams were preceded by an unprecedented year in Wisconsin education. These results are only one of many data points that should be considered in quantifying the quality of a school and in driving school improvement.
- 3. WISEdash: Test participation for 2020-21 may be lower than in other years due to the COVID-19 pandemic. When making comparisons to the state or across years or districts, use caution when participation rates are lower than 95%, especially when the group of tested students is not representative of the overall population of students.

WI Forward Exam



WI Forward Exam Purpose

Provides information about student performance which allows:

- 1. students to reflect on their achievement;
- 2. teachers to target instruction to student needs and reflect upon their own instructional practices;
- administrators to more fully understand what students know and can do in order to guide curriculum and professional development decisions;
- 4. parents/guardians to understand what their child knows and is able to do in ELA, mathematics, science, and social studies; and
- 5. all stakeholders to check how ready ALL students are for college and career, especially those groups that have historically been left behind.




















