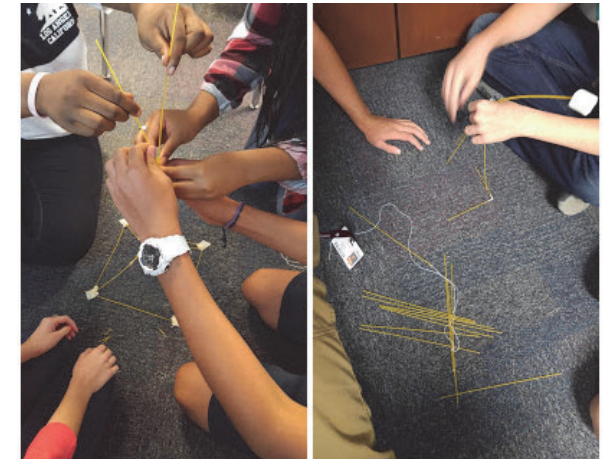
All clubs are student led and teacher guided. We also have students who participate in TCC clubs and select sports leagues outside of school.
