## HOLIDAYS SEASON REMINDER

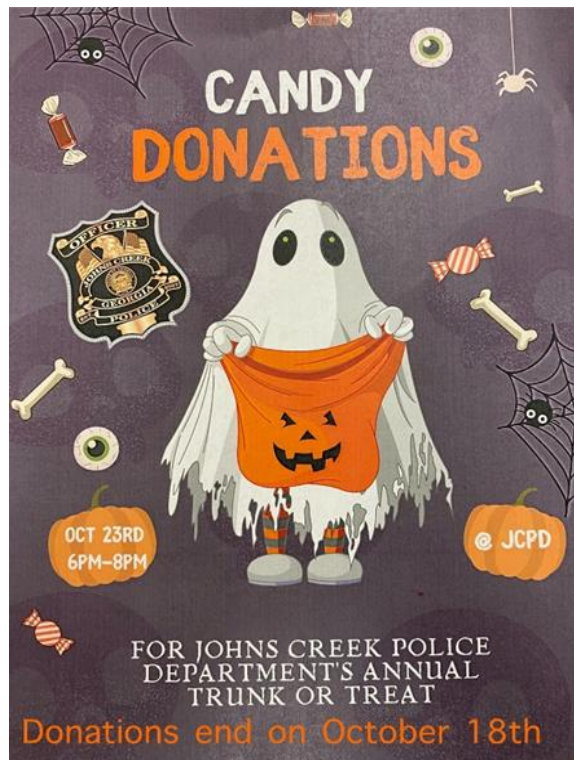

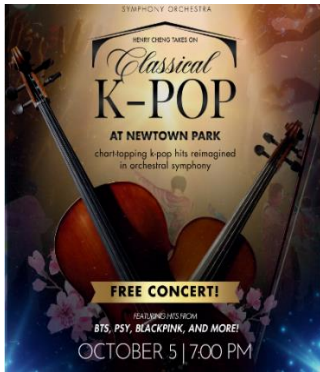
