Harassment, Intimidation, Bullying

Good Natured Teasing

- Involves playful back-and-forth between both parties
- Is accompanied by a friendly tone of voice and laughter
- Brings people closer and encourages friendships
- Sometimes helps lighten a tense or angry situation
- Does not lead to physical confrontation

Conflict

- Occurs when peers feel equal in power
- Can be solved by communicating with one another using an "I feel" statement OR without help from an adult
- Can be described as a misunderstanding
- Typically is short-term

Hurtful Bullying

- May be accompanied by an angry tone of voice
- May be accompanied by angry body language, such as clenched fists
- Continues even when the person being teased shows distress
- Continues even when the person teasing knows the topic is upsetting others
- Demonstrates an imbalance of power between the students

What is HIB?

Any gesture, any written, verbal or physical act, or any electronic communication
 A single incident or a series of incidents
 Reasonably perceived as being motivated either by any actual or perceived characteristic such as
 Race, color, religion, ancestry, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, gender identity and expression, or a mental, physical or sensory disability, or by any other distinguishing characteristic

Takes place on school property, at any school sponsored function, on a school bus, or off school grounds*
Substantially disrupts or interferes with the orderly operation of the school or the rights of other students
Has the effect of insulting or demeaning any student or group of students

 Creates a hostile educational environment for the student by interfering with a student's education or by severely or pervasively causing physical or emotional harm to the student • A reasonable person should know, under the circumstances, what will have the effect of physically or emotionally harming a student or damaging the student's property, or placing a student in reasonable fear of physical or emotional harm to his person or damage to his property
