Bid Rates above are calculated by BOCES as a factor of the current prevailing wage rate (Rate Bid/Current Prevailing Rate = the factor that will be applied to calculate the new rate). In the event that there is a change in the rates under the PRC Schedules secured with the Department of Labor for this solicitation, this factor will be utilized to calculate the new rates that will apply for any contract(s) awarded for under this solicitation. *All other rates and/or percentages shall remain the same.*

Example:

Rate Bid = \$110, Current Total Hourly Wage according to NYS DOL = \$62.70

Calculation to find the factor: $\$110/\$62.70 = 1.754$ Factor

If NYS DOL issues a change and the new schedule sets the new Total Hourly Wage at \$72.65

To calculate the new rate under this bid:

New PRC Rate $\$72.65 \times$ Factor Above $1.754 = \$127.43$; **$\127.43 is the new "Rate Bid".**
