Harmony Elementary seeks to inform and provide numerous opportunities for parents to engage in their children's educational experience. By partnering together parents and school employees can work towards maximizing the learning environment for each student. Harmony Elementary engages our parents via the following communication endeavors.

Availability & Timely Communication-Teachers, staff, and administration seek to return all calls and digital communication within 24 hours. (Weekends excluded.) All teachers have personal voicemail to ensure that messages reach them as quickly as possible. Teachers and administrators are available to meet with parents during the school day as long as it does not impede classroom instruction. After school meetings are also available.

Online Communication-Parents can gain information about school activities via the school website and the school Facebook account. Topics include grade level information, the history of our school, and school policies and programs.

Mass Communication/Notification-Parents will receive a weekly automated call that will inform parents of school events, activities, academic initiatives, and community engagements. The message is also sent out via email.

Class Dojo-Teachers regularly communicate with parents via the Class Dojo application. The application allows quick two way communication between teachers and parents regarding child progress, classroom behavior, classroom events, and important reminders about upcoming instruction.

PTO (Parent Teacher Organization)-All parents/guardians have an opportunity to participate in this group. Members work to improve the educational experience for all students via fundraising, coordinating and holding special events, purchasing items and supplies for the school, and volunteering.
