

### School Safety and the November 5 Levy Proposal

School safety is one of the key components of the upcoming levy proposal on Election Day, November 5. The proposal outlines plans to enhance security across all schools with the following measures:

- Classroom Security: Update and standardize classroom door locks for quick emergency locking.
- **Perimeter Security**: Improve security with additional surveillance cameras and security film on entrance windows.
- High School Security: Construct a more secure lower-level entrance at Prior Lake High School.

These safety updates are based on recommendations from an audit conducted by the U.S. Dept. of Homeland Security - Cybersecurity & Infrastructure Security Agency.

### Safety Response Protocol Drills

Student safety is our top priority. One way we prioritize safety is by practicing a number of safety response protocol drills. We have already conducted our first fire drill evacuation and have also already

had our first "Hold" drill. A Hold would be called in the event there is something that necessitates the hallways being kept clear such as a medical emergency. In a Hold, we clear the halls, close and lock doors, but teachers and students continue on with teaching and learning as normal in the classrooms. Coming up in the month of October, we will be conducting an evacuation drill with relocation. In the relocation portion, staff and students will walk to Twin Oaks Middle School. We would call a relocation in the event we evacuated and the building was deemed unsafe to return to. We will also be practicing our first Lockdown drill in October. While this seems like a lot of drills, we want to make sure that all staff and students are prepared in the event of an actual emergency.
