Word Study

The West Chester Area School District word study scope and sequence focuses on concept development. Spelling is not how many words a teacher covers or assigns. True spelling mastery is the ability to spell words correctly in everyday writing.

In grades 1-3, the word study program focuses on learning to read and learning to spell. The program teaches high frequency and phonetically regular words through various activities. Frequent assessments of students work and classroom spelling dictations will determine how well the students are progressing.

Research has shown that children learn to spell in a fairly predictable series of developmental stages, and that these steps build on one another. The word study scope and sequence teaches the rules and patterns of spelling. The words used correspond with the units in the Project Read phonology program.

Word Study Activities for at Home

- Use magnetic letters on the refrigerator to build words from the word lists (add or change letters to make new words)
- Make 2 sets of word cards from the word lists and play memory
- Think of other words that rhyme with the word cards
- Choose 2-3 words to create a sentence or sentences
- Play "Word Detective"- Say to your child, "I'm thinking of a word that....." and provide them with a clue so that the answer is a word from their list
- Play "Hangman"
- Play games such as Scrabble Jr. or Boggle Jr.
- READ, READ to your child- continue to expose them to words.
