
HIGH SCHOOL + BEYOND PLAN

TRANSCRIPTS

- An unofficial copy of your transcript should be uploaded in Xello by end of the day Monday, 09/30
- Transcripts currently in Skyward are not up to date
- IMPORTANT: Go over your transcript to check everything is correct
 - (Grade Replacements, Middle School grades, Running Start, etc.)
- Reach out to your Counselor ASAP if you notice a mistake so your college application has your correct transcript



COLLEGE APPLICATION WORKSHOPS

- Students CAN (and should) submit their materials whenever they are done
- They do not need to wait for the counselor/teacher we will make sure to get your materials in by the deadline (with enough notice), but we follow deadline listed on application
- Using AI to help in the process!
 - Ex. I am looking for a college where I can study psychology and that has an animal behavior lab
 - Ex. Are any of these schools known for a strong sense of community?

APPLICATION PROCESS: 4YEAR COLLEGES

Transcript: Uploaded by Counselor in Common App or Ms. Johnson(registrar)

Application: Personal Information, Essay, Extracurricular Activities

SAT/ACT*: Must send score reports directly from testing agencies

COMMON APP SCHOOL REPORTS VS LETTERS OF REC



SCHOOL REPORT

- EVERY school on the Common App requires your counselor to complete a School Report
- In this report we list your GPA, submit your transcript, and a copy of your 12th grade schedule
- You need to list your Counselor under the "Counselor Recommender" section by email.
- You can submit the student portion of the application AT ANY TIME. You need to give your counselor at least 2 full weeks to complete their portion (2 weeks before your 1st deadline). Do not wait for your counselor to submit your application.
- Make sure your college deadlines are correct in Common App, we use that to ensure we complete your School Report in time.


COUNSELOR LETTER OF RECOMMENDATION

- Some schools (NOT all) require your counselor to write a letter of recommendation in addition to the school report.
- Before asking your counselor to complete this you need to double check at least one school you are applying to on the Common App requires a "counselor recommendation" (remember: this is different than a school report)
- If you have a school that requires a Counselor Letter of Recommendation you need to complete the <u>individual Form for your counselor</u>.






HOW TO ADD TEACHER RECOMMENDERS



ENTERING HIGH SCHOOL COURSEWORK

- Even if you are taking a course at an accelerated pace (e.g. Geometry in 9th grade, the course level is still 'Regular/Standard')
- 'Honors' and 'Advanced Placement' only apply if they are in the title of the course
- If taking CHC (College in the High School), only select 'Dual Enrollment' if you applied for dual enrollment and earned college credit. Use 'Advanced' if IHS credit only.
- Office Assistant/TA Course level = 'n/a'

APPLICATION PROCESS: 2-YEAR COLLEGES

There are 29 community colleges and 5 technical colleges in Washington State. Visit www.sbctc.edu for more information about each school!

Steps to apply:

- 1. Complete the online admission application
- 2. Follow directions for each school's placement process (COMPASS, ACCUPLACER, High School Transcript, etc.)
- 3. Register for classes

Note: 2-year and technical colleges don't require the SAT or ACT. Typically these applications are completed in the springtime. They have more flexible deadlines, but specific programs within each school can fill up so don't wait too long!





ADMISSION TERMS

- Rolling Admissions: Colleges evaluate apps as they are received vs waiting to evaluate at a set deadline
- <u>Pooling Admissions:</u> Colleges evaluate apps in a "pool". No applications are reviewed until the deadline Ex. UW
- <u>Deferred Admissions:</u> A 2nd chance at admission, your application will be reviewed at a different time
- Early Action: Students receive an early response to their app but do not have to commit to the college early
- Early Decision: Students receive an early response to their app and are in a **BINDING** agreement







FAFSA & WASFA, SCHOLARSHIPS



FAFSA + WASFA

- Deadline June 2025
- This applies for federal access to grants, scholarships, loans, work-study
- You will need parent/guardian assistance needed if you are a dependent student
- It is typically recommended to complete the application even if you don't think your financial situation will qualify (required for some scholarships)

WASFA (Washington Application for Financial Aid)

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

How many seniors are in the senior class?

656

Do I need to send a transcript?

Most schools require a transcript (not all, ex. UW does not during admission process). If using Common App or SEND Edu your counselor will send it. Any other schools, you request a transcript using the Form and mail it yourself.

Does EHS rank students?

No. The entire district does not rank.

What is my weighted GPA?

We do not weight GPA. Colleges will weight your GPA for you if it is necessary.



Do I need my counselor to write a LOR?



Not necessarily. Check the admissions requirements to see if a Counselor LOR is required.



Can I submit my Common App before my counselor/teacher has finished?



YES! ☺



How do I send ACT/SAT test scores?



Through their individual websites.



When do I apply to colleges such as Bellevue College, Cascadia, etc.?



Not until early spring, but you want to complete the FAFSA/WAFSA in December for Financial Aid

What is the significance of the Community Service Honor Cord?


