Extreme Weather Driving Tips

- Check the condition of windshield wipers and fluids
- Keep your gas tank at least half full
- Slow Down and increase following distance
- Avoid sudden stops and starts
- Use extra caution on bridges and ramps where ice can form without warning
- Do not use cruise control
- Remove ice and snow from windows, mirrors, lights, hood and roof of vehicle
- Carry a winter emergency travel kit:
 - * Flashlight and Batteries, Battery operated Radio
 - * Jumper Cables, Snow Shovel
 - * Cell phone Charger; Ice Scraper and Sand
 - * First Aid Supplies
 - * Extra Warm Clothing, Gloves, Blanket
 - * Bottled Water, Non-Perishable Food
