2 TIPS SENT TO 24/7 CRISIS CENTER

- 1. Crisis counselor ensures tip has enough information**
- 2. MAY ask more questions via “2-way anonymous dialogue”**
- 3. Forwards tip to school officials and police (as needed)**

3 INTERVENE AND HELP

1. **School Officials and Police** (as needed) immediately assess, intervene and take action to protect students
2. **School Officials** report outcomes into the Say Something system to ensure accountability and follow-up of tips





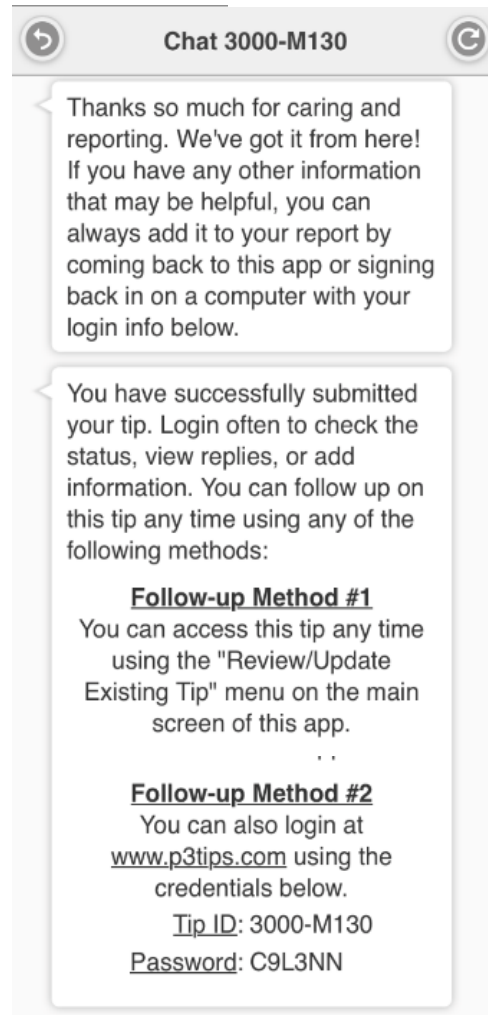

AFTER YOU SUBMIT A TIP YOU WILL RECEIVE

Acknowledgement and thanks to the user for submitting tip

Statement to tipster that s/he can check the status, view replies or add more information to a submitted tip

TWO methods to check status, view replies or add information:
1) Via the app and the "review/update existing tip
2) Via website and input of the tip ID number and password

HOW *do I* SUBMIT A TIP ON THE WEBSITE?

1. Go to **SAYSOMETHING.NET** – Select “Submit a Tip” then Complete Form:

HOW *do I* SUBMIT A TIP BY PHONE?

1. **CALL 1-844-5-SAYNOW (1-844-572-9669)**
2. **A crisis counselor will ask a series of questions – such as:**
 - School district and school name
 - Description of situation, individuals involved
 - Location details (as needed) and other details to assess the situation
3. **At the end of the call, you will receive a Tip Number and Password to allow you to:**
 - Login online and provide new and/or additional information
 - View private messages requesting additional anonymous information from you
