At MEVA, we demonstrate our commitment to parent/Learning Coach participation by hosting dozens of team meetings each week to review students' academic progress and to make programming adjustments as needed. We send weekly messages that keep all our families informed about their responsibilities within the MEVA community. Annually, we provide a meeting to outline MEVA's ESEA/Title schoolwide student supports, such as Middle School and High School Help Desk, and to answer any questions about how to access these resources and more.
