HOLIDAYS SEASON REMINDER

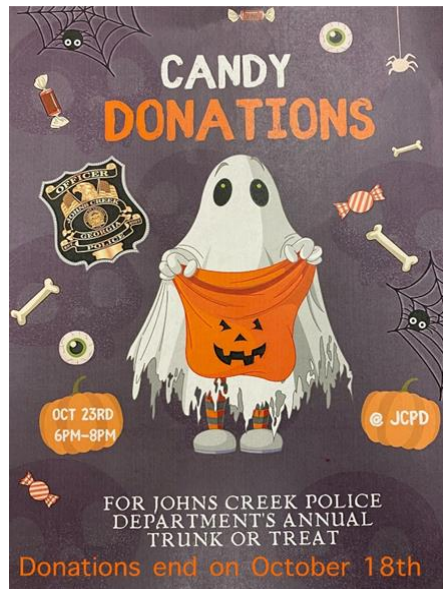

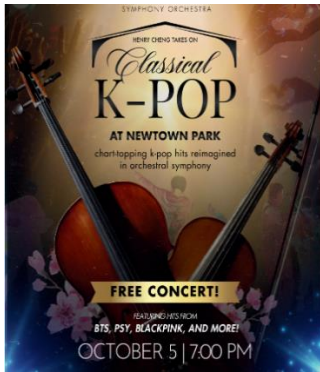
