### **GOALS FOR THE 24-25 SCHOOL YEAR**

- PERFORMANCE
- NWEA MAP Growth 65% of students will meet/exceed their projected growth in reading and math from Fall to Spring
- M-STEP proficiency increase student proficiency in math and reading by 20% per each content area-(rdg-20%/math 20%-both)- as compared to the previous year

\*PSAT –Increase the college readiness by 20% as compared to the previous year.

#### ATTENDANCE

- Chronic absenteeism and tardies Decrease by 15% in comparison to the previous year's rate (both CA and Tardies)
- \* Increase ADA Goal is 95%

#### INTERVENTION


• Students will have an average mastery of 80% or higher of skills during scheduled intervention time.

## Student Attendance

Good attendance is very important. It is imperative that students are at school daily and on time! Student performance is greatly affected by their ability to be in class daily and mentally present. School hours are from 8:00-3:30 this week forward. One of our Glazer values is being on time! Remember students are tardy after 8:05. We need our students in school every day ready to learn. There is a new policy in regards to tardies! All students arriving after 8:05 MUST BE SIGNED IN THE MAIN OFFICE.

Remember our goal is to reduce our chronic absenteeism by 20% from 54% to 34% and to increase our average daily attendance from 86% to 95%!

All students who attend each day during the first week of school will earn 5 free dress passes!

## Ms. Morgan's Attendance Tip of the Week

- Make school attendance a priority.
- Talk about the importance of showing up to school every day. Help your child maintain daily routines, such as finishing homework and getting a good night's sleep.

## When is too Sick for School?

Keep students home if they: Have a temp above 100. Return 24 hrs after clear Are throwing up or have diarrhea. Return 24 hrs after clear Eyes are pink and crusty. Return after Dr. visit Have a runny nose or sniffles not related to allergies relieved by allergy medicine with no other symptoms and not getting better after a few days. A slight cough with no other symptoms not getting better after a few days with cough medicine. Remember our goal is to reduce our chronic absenteeism by 15% from 54% to 39% and to increase our average daily attendance from 86% to 95%!



**NWEA** Glazer scholars will be taking the Measures of Academic

Progress or MAP. It creates a personalized assessment experience by adapting to each student's learning level - precisely measuring student progress and growth for each individual. Teachers will have essential information about what each student knows and is ready to learn within 24 hours and thusly be able to use it to inform instruction.

Testing occurs three times per year and begins within the first weeks of September. Please review the resources for additional information!
