PERFORMANCE

- M-STEP proficiency – increase student proficiency in math and reading by 20% per each content area-(rdg-20%/math 20%-both)- as compared to the previous year
- *PSAT –Increase the college readiness by 20% as compared to the previous year.

- * Increase ADA - Goal is 95%

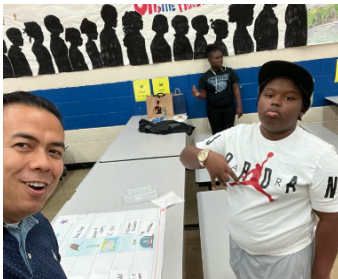
INTERVENTION

What is the Right to Counsel hour?
In the City of Detroit, there's a law called Right-to-Counsel (RTC) that helps people who rent their homes and are facing eviction. This law gives low-income tenants or tenants the right to have a free lawyer represent them in court. Some courts have adopted the Right-to-Counsel and other tenant resources that support housing security.
