

The Colton Joint Unified School District has always maintained a long range facilities master plan. The current planning effort is geared toward updating that plan. It is the District's stated goal to maintain this plan, to continue to make it relevant, to make decisions based on the goals identified in the plan, and to use the plan to prioritize how to utilize financial resources that may be available over time for maintaining, renovating and building new facilities within the District.

The District recognizes that students and staff perform best in comfortable environments that support collaboration, flexibility, have access to fresh air, daylighting, quality acoustics, clean restrooms, clean classrooms, access to the outdoors and do not unreasonably restrict activity.
