Stacy M. Allen - Dansville High School, Class of 2003:

During her time, Stacy Allen earned 14 varsity letters. As a 5 year member of the Varsity Cross Country team, she acquired 3 Section V Championships (2 individual and 1 team). Stacy was a 3x Livingston County Athletics Association All-Star, 1x All-Section V Team member, 3x State Qualifier, 2x Team MVP, and a 4x Team Captain. In the winter season, Stacy was a 1 year member of the Varsity Swimming and Diving team. She was also a 3 year member of the Varsity Alpine Ski team. During the spring sports season, Stacy was a 5 year member of the Varsity Outdoor Track & Field team. She received Meet of Champions Honors 4x and was a 4x Team Captain. After graduating from Dansville High School, Stacy attended the University of Rochester where she earned 9 varsity letters in Cross Country and Track & Field.

Kate Mosca - Athlete - Dansville High School, Class of 2013

Kate Mosca excelled as a student athlete while at Dansville High School. She was the Salutatorian of her graduating class and was an exceptional swimmer. As a 5-year member of the varsity swim team, Kate earned 18 sectional patches winning 7 individual titles, 8 relay titles and 3 team titles. In addition to being a Section V Champion, Kate broke 6 school records while swimming at Dansville. She also broke multiple pool, LCAA and Section V Class C records. She was a 5x Livingston County Athletic Association All-Star, a member of the All-Greater Rochester swim team and a Dansville team captain. Kate qualified for the NYS Championship Meet for 4 consecutive years where she was a finalist in multiple events. In 2011, Kate was the LCAA Co-Outstanding Performer of the Meet. In 2012, Kate was the LCAA Senior Swimmer of the Year, Section V Swimmer of the Meet and an individual finalist in the NYS Championships in the 200 IM. Kate earned the title of State Champion after helping Section V win the 2012 NYS Championship Meet. During her time at Dansville, Kate was awarded the MVP Award and Coaches Award for Outstanding Achievement in Mustang Athletics. After graduating from Dansville High School, Kate attended Division 1 Marist College where she was a 4x member of the MAAC Championship winning swim team, a member of the MAAC All-Academic Team and was awarded the President's Academic Achievement Award.

Sarah Mosca - Athlete - Dansville High School, Class of 2013

Sarah Mosca excelled as a student athlete while at Dansville High School. She was the Valedictorian of her graduating class and was an exceptional swimmer. As a 5-year member of the varsity swim team, Sarah earned 19 sectional patches winning 8 individual titles, 8 relay titles and 3 team titles. In addition to being a Section V Champion, Sarah broke 7 school records during her time at Dansville. She also broke numerous pool, LCAA, and Section V Class C records. She was a 5x LCAA All-Star, was selected as a member of the All-Greater Rochester swim team 4 years in a row, was a Dansville team captain, and was selected as Section V Sportsperson of the Year during her senior year. In 2011, Sarah was the LCAA Co-Outstanding Performer of the Meet and earned the same award individually in 2012. Sarah also represented Dansville for 4 consecutive years at the NYS Championship Meet, making finals in multiple individual and relay events and finishing in the top 8 in the 100 butterfly and 100 breaststroke during her senior season. Sarah earned the title of State Champion after helping Section V win the 2012 NYS Championship Meet. During her time at Dansville, Sarah was awarded the Rookie of Year, MVP and Coaches Award for Outstanding Achievement in Mustang Athletics. After graduating from Dansville High School, Sarah attended Division I Marist College where she was a 4x member of the MAAC Championship winning swim team, as well as the MAAC All-Academic Team. She was honored as a CSCAA Individual Scholar All-American and was named team captain during her senior season.

Jim Welch, Jr. - Athlete - Dansville High School, Class of 2005

Jimmy Welch, Jr. was a 3 sport athlete at Dansville High School. As a member of the Cross Country team (Varsity letterman for 2 years), Jimmy accomplished a Livingston County Championship, qualified for Sectionals, and earned a NYS Section V Boys Class C Team Championship. During the winter season, Jimmy was a 4 year varsity swimmer. In this sport he qualified for Sectionals in multiple events all 4 years, was a

member of the NYS Section V Class C Championship Team and 200 Free Relay Team, a Section V Champion in the 100 Breaststroke, 2x Team MVP, Co-Captain, and at the time of graduation held the school records for the 200 IM and 200 Freestyle relay. During the spring sports season, Jimmy was a 4 year member of the Track & Field team. He qualified for Sectionals 3 times, was a Team Captain and holds the current pole vault record for boys. Jimmy was the recipient of the Dedicated Junior Athlete Award (in honor of Gary Lemen) as well as the John Nelson Award. After graduating from DHS, Jimmy attended SUNY Oswego where he was a 4 year member of both the swim team and track & field team.
