### COMMUNITY

Canandaigua, the ancient "chosen spot" of the Seneca Nation of the Iroquois Confederacy, is located at the north end of Canandaigua Lake in the beautiful Finger Lakes Region of upstate New York State. The City of Canandaigua has a population of about 11,000. It is the county seat for Ontario County, the fastest growing county in the Rochester metropolitan area, located 26 miles southeast of Rochester and 5 miles from New York State Thruway exit 44. This allows for residents to be employed locally and in surrounding communities within the fields of light industry, business, trades and professions.

### SCHOOL

Canandaigua Academy was founded in 1791 as a private academy for boys. Today it is a small, public city high school with a coed population of 1,044 students in grades 9-12. The 2023-24 senior enrollment includes 274 students.
