Skills to be developed throughout the course:

Reading Literature and Informational Text

- Find key ideas and details in both literature and informational text
- Determine theme of a story, poem, and/or drama
- Describe elements of a story, poem, drama such as characters, setting, or events
- Analyze the craft and structure of a text in multiple genres and with varying narration
- Make connections within a text
- Compare and contrast various themes and topics
- Determine the overall structure of a text
- Use reasons and evidence to support points in a text

Grammar

- Apply word analysis skills to determine word meanings
- Produce complete sentences and recognize fragment and run - on sentences
- Form and use proper use of standard conventional patterns
- Demonstrate commands of proper capitalization, punctuation, and spelling

Writing

- Write opinion pieces with reasons and evidence as support
- Write informative/explanatory pieces to examine a topic and convey ideas
- Write narratives to develop real or imagined experiences
- Use dialogue and description to develop experiences and events
- Conduct short research projects incorporating different aspects of a topic or perspective
