MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING *Girls Incorporated of Metropolitan Dallas*

This is a memorandum of understanding between Girls Incorporated of Metropolitan Dallas (Girls Inc.) and the Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute, for the delivery and evaluation of the Girls Inc. Experience, specifically the Girls Inc. Club for the duration of the Fall 2019 and Spring 2020 school semesters.

PROGRAMMING

Girls Inc. Club: Girls will be provided with enjoyable and instructive life changing programs and experiences that will equip them to overcome serious barriers to grow up strong (healthy living), smart (academic enrichment), and bold (life skills) in a pro-girl and girls-only environment that is physically, socially and emotionally safe and affirms that girls can succeed and deserve to be taken seriously.

These objectives will be achieved by providing trusting, mentoring relationships with trained adult staff and volunteers; holistic, compensatory, and intentional programming that exposes girls to experiences and options they otherwise might not have, and girl-centered, motivating, and interactive activities that develop and promote girls' strengths.

RESPONSIBILITIES

To help meet these objectives:

Girls Inc. shall:

- A. Deliver the Girls Inc. curriculum
- B. Provide instructors
- C. Provide program supplies

Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute shall:

- A. Provide meeting space at no cost to Girls Inc.
- B. Market and register for course(s)
- D. Provide technology, TV, DVD player and projector screen
- E. Communicate at least 24 hours in advance schedule changes, cancellations, etc. In case of emergencies such as school closures and/or all after-school activity cancellations due to bad weather, or the threat of bad weather (for example), cell phone contact list calls should be implemented immediately.
- F. Provide staff member(s) to oversee and sponsor students and accompany registered girls to and from class
- G. Ensure girls are in class/club before agreed upon session time; if girls do not arrive in class within 15 minutes, facilitator can cancel session for the day.

INSURANCE

The Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute shall obtain and maintain in full force for the duration of the period of service or agreement, at their sole expense, insurance coverage in the following type(s) and amounts:

Commercial General Liability Insurance: including, but not limited to, Premises/Operations, Personal & Advertising Injury, Products/Completed Operations, Independent Contractors and Contractual Liability with minimum combined bodily injury (including death) and property damage limits of 1,000,000 per occurrence.

Worker's Compensation with statutory limits; Employers Liability with minimum limits for bodily injury: a) by accident, \$500,000 per each accident, b) by disease, \$500,000 per employee with a per policy aggregate of \$500,000.

Girls Inc. shall obtain and maintain in full force for the duration of the period of service or agreement, at their sole expense, Commercial General Liability Insurance: including, but not limited to, Premises/Operations, Personal & Advertising Injury, Products/Completed Operations, Independent Contractors and Contractual Liability with minimum combined bodily injury (including death) and property damage limits of 1,000,000 per occurrence.

On or before August 1, 2019 Girls Inc. shall furnish the School for the Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute with a certificate of insurance demonstrating proof of insurance coverage and limits set forth above.

INDEMNIFICATION

The Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify Girls Inc. from any claim, suit, or loss, sustained by Girls Inc., its officers, directors, employees, or agents for any asserted property damage, injury, or death of any person to the extent that it results from or is caused by the asserted sole ordinary negligence of the School for the Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute its employees, or its agents.

Likewise, Girls Inc. hereby agrees to hold harmless and indemnify the Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute from any claim, suit, or loss, sustained by the Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute or any asserted property damage, injury, or death of any person to the extent that it results from or is caused by the asserted sole ordinary negligence of Girls Inc., or its officers, directors, employees, or agents.

For the purposes of this clause, "agents" of Girls Inc. does not include the Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute, its employees, or its agents, and likewise, "agents" of the Grand Prairie Collegiate Institute does not include Girls Inc., its officers, directors, employees, or agents."


TERMINATION


