We are grateful for our school community. We will work collectively to ensure we are able to leave our children, for generations to come, with an even better community and school than we have today. On Tuesday, December 5th we will be voting on the proposed Capital Improvement Project highlighted in this special edition newsletter to continue working by the RCS Core Value stated above.



Our special school, the school that so many graduates are

proud to call their alma mater, and the school that we aspire to have many future generations successfully graduate from, needs to be taken care of through thoughtful planning of buildings and grounds renovations, upgrades, restorations, and reconstruction. While this proposed project does not include any flashy new additions, it contains the necessary repair and replacement of essential items at both buildings and the bus garage.

A total project cost of \$9,905,000 includes the use of \$2,225,000 from our Capital Reserves. The remaining balance of the project will be funded through construction bonds. All eligible construction expenses will be aided at 83.5%. This proposed capital improvement project yields no anticipated tax impact for our community.

We will be hosting a public information session on Tuesday, November 14, 2023, at 6:00 PM in the elementary library. Please consider joining us to learn more about the proposed project. The Capital Project vote will take place on Tuesday, December 5, 2023 between the hours of 1:00 PM and 8:00 PM in the Remsen Elementary cafeteria. Voter parking spaces will be reserved at the front of the elementary parking lot closest to the cafeteria doors.

SCOPE OF WORK

CURRENT CONDITIONS

Site Improvements

- Reconstruct parking lots and drive lanes throughout the campus
- Replace sidewalks in select locations
- Reconstruct exterior ramp near Jr./Sr. HS Gym
- Improve drainage at varsity soccer field

Jr./Sr. High School

- Replace door hardware in select locations
- Upgrades and improvements to gymnasium and stage (gym floor restoration, replacement of sound system, and replacement of stage and pit lights)
- Replacement of gym doors, frames and hardware
- Repoint masonry, reconstruct chimney
- Replace all interior stair treads, risers and tile on landings
- Replace air handling equipment on five units
- Heating and ventilation improvements to seven spaces
- Renovate restrooms by the Nurse's Office
- Replace piping in kitchen

Elementary School

- Replace concrete pad at underground fuel tank
- Reconstruct loading dock
- Replace remaining exterior doors and hardware
- Repoint masonry and reconstruct all lintels
- Replace all windows, including window treatments
- Replace carpet and VCT flooring in all classrooms and other spaces
- Replace three hot water inline pumps and cabinet heaters, provide additional pump
- Upgrade temperature control system to direct digital controls
- Replace emergency and exit lighting
- Replace gym wall pads
- Replace curtains and accordion doors at stage
- Replace exhaust fans, pumps and piping

Bus Garage

- Replace bus lift
- Replace pump and piping
- Replace HVAC control system
- Replace water heater
- Replace fire alarm system
