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Remsen School District Comprehensive Guidance Plan

The following pages outline the district-wide Counseling and Guidance plan. In accordance with the national standards for a school counseling program, as set forth by the American School Counseling Association, the primary function of the school counseling department is to facilitate student development in three broad content areas: academic development, career development and personal/social development. Therefore, we targeted these three areas as goals throughout each grade level providing a clear understanding of how we are to meet the goals set by the American School Counseling Association. The district comprehensive Guidance Plan also supports the Remsen School District's Mission Statement.

The purpose of the guidance plan, in accordance with the revised Commissioner's Regulations adopted by the New York State Board of Regents in July 1982, which can be found at www.emsc.nysesd.gov/part100/pages/1002a.html, is to serve all students in grades K-12 equitably. It is to graduate all students with the understanding necessary to achieve their personal, educational, vocational, and social potentials throughout life. As required, the plan includes objectives, activities, resources and staffing, along with an assessment and provisions for an annual review or revision.

Specifically, the guidance plan contains a variety of counseling and guidance strategies, which allows counselors to maximize their talents, and offers the ability to address the needs of our student population. The plan will define and outline how to efficiently deliver those services, which counselors provide for students throughout the district. It is not intended to be a summary of all that our staff does throughout the course of the year.

ASCA National Model Overview

School counselors design and deliver school counseling programs that improve student outcomes.
