

# TRANSITION AT ISKL



OUR SCHOOL USES SPAN AS A MODEL FOR EXCELLENCE IN TRANSITION PROGRAMMING

- Whether starting school for the first time or transitioning from another school, ISKL's support framework and culture of care and empathy ensure both students and families feel at home from the moment they enroll. We believe that healthy transitions happen when a school community offers opportunities to reflect on what it means to be in a highly mobile environment and by giving students the tools they need to navigate life as a third or cross-cultural student, including lessons on identity, third culture identity, the RAFT, and belonging.
- ISKL aims to support families in building resilience to understand that mixed emotions are a natural process of transitional transformation. It is important for adults to understand their own feelings to translate a positive perception and response mechanism onto their children. Here is an overview of the transition our new families and leaving families are experiencing during their time within our community:

## NEW FAMILIES

Students and parents will join a dedicated Orientation day for new families

Peers Helpers support students in Middle School and High School

Students in High School can virtually meet with their counselors once enrolled

A dedicated website for new families with relevant information about their move to ISKL

New families will be matched with a current family



Parents-led Welcome coffee mornings

PTA and School-led "Parent Assist" workshop with a presentation for the Nurses, Risk Management, Shared Services

The ES counselors team also organizes a dedicated parent workshop to support new families



## LEAVING FAMILIES

For students leaving at the end of the academic year, rituals and acknowledgment within their division

For students leaving at the end of Semester one, acknowledgment within their division

For students leaving during a semester, check out with their divisional counseling office

For all students, an alumni parting gift

For parents leaving at the end of the academic year, a school-wide parent-leaver workshop providing tools to navigate their transition will be offered
