- Sweet Sapphire grapes grow in large, loose clusters averaging 16 centimeters in diameter and 29 centimeters in length.
- Sweet Sapphire grapes have a sweet, neutral flavor suited for fresh and cooked preparations.
- Sweet Sapphire grapes are available in the Northern Hemisphere in the late summer through early fall, with a peak season in late August through mid-September.

FUN FACT!

Sweet Sapphire grapes were created in 2004 by fruit geneticist Dr. David Cain of International Fruit Genetics, also known as IFG, a table grape breeding company in California.
