

RAVE APPLE

DID YOU KNOW?

- Rave apples are a small to medium-sized varietal, averaging 6 to 8 centimeters in diameter, and have a conical to round, sometimes lopsided shape.
- Rave apples are available in the late summer through early fall.
- Rave apples have a sweet-tart flavor and crisp flesh designed to be consumed in fresh preparations. The apples are primarily eaten straight, out of hand, and are popularly served chilled to enhance their juicy nature.

FUN FACT!

Rave apples were developed through the University of Minnesota's Apple Breeding Program in 1997 under the cultivar name MN55. Famous apple breeder David Bedford created the variety in partnership with James Luby, and the apples are descendants of a natural cross between Honeycrisp apples and MonArk apples,
