

PICKLING CUCUMBER


DID YOU KNOW?

- Pickling Cucumbers are members of the Cucurbitaceae, or gourd family.
- Pickling Cucumbers are primarily used for preserving or canning.
- Pickling Cucumbers have thin skins, are short and blocky, and usually have a color gradient from dark green at the stem end to light green at the blossom end.
- A Cucumber is more than 95% water!

FUN FACT!

The word "pickle" comes from the Dutch word, pekel, which means brine or salt.





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
