This year, we are excited to introduce a new Language Arts curriculum designed to ensure students engage in daily reading, writing, and meaningful discussions. The curriculum we've selected is called Bookworms, which emphasizes building oral language and vocabulary, especially for our younger learners. We recognize that these skills are crucial for developing successful readers and writers.

Our Language Arts instruction will be divided into three key blocks:

Shared Reading: This block focuses on reading, discussions, and comprehension, helping students improve their ability to understand and analyze texts.

ELA Block: During this time, students will engage in interactive read-alouds, which are designed to expand their vocabulary and deepen their understanding of more complex texts. Writing activities, such as sentence composing, will also be a central part of this block.

Foundational Skills: For this block, we will use the UFLI curriculum, which focuses on strengthening phonemic awareness and decoding skills, essential for becoming a proficient reader and writer.

We are thrilled to bring this comprehensive curriculum to our district and look forward to seeing our students grow and thrive!

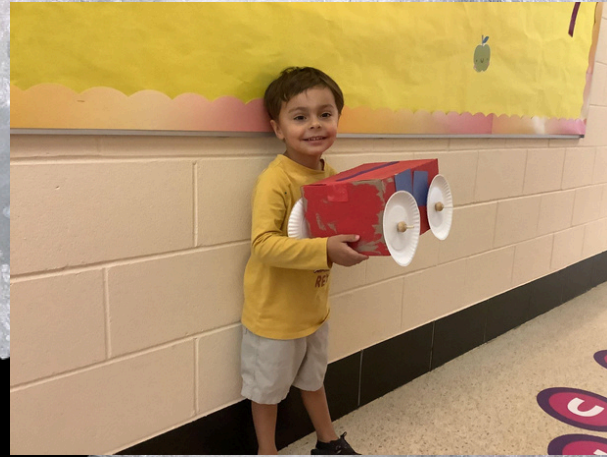


Preschool Teachers-Miss Hix, Miss Neuhart, Miss Porterfield and Mrs. Miller
