












STUDENTS ATTEND LAB FOR ROUGHLY THREE HOURS PER DAY







D/CC APPLICATION PROCESS

- APPROXIMATELY 25 SEATS PER PROGRAM
- LOTTERY PROCESS
- COUNSELORS CHECK TO SEE WHETHER APPLICANTS
 - LIVE IN SCHOOL DISTRICT
 - ARE ON TRACK TO GRADUATE
 - MET PRIORITY DEADLINE
- THOSE WHO MEET ALL THREE BASELINE CRITERIA ENTERED INTO FIRST LOTTERY ROUND FOR PROGRAM THEY APPLIED FOR
- BLIND LOTTERY HELD
- STUDENTS WILL EITHER BE ACCEPTED OR WAITLISTED INITIALLY (PROCESS CONTINUES UNTIL FALL)
- APPLICANTS ARE NOTIFIED OF STATUS IN EARLY FEB. (NEW STUDENT ONBOARDING BEGINS)
