**A.** Approval of Award of Contract with Medallion Contracting, Inc. for the site utility work for the Southern Kern Unified School District New Cafeteria at Rosamond High Early College Campus in the amount of \$9,947,698.00 – Irving

On Thursday, July 27, 2023, bids were opened for Site Work for the Southern Kern Unified School District New Cafeteria at Rosamond High Early College Campus. The following are the results of the bid opening for the bid scope:

Medallion Contracting, Inc., Lancaster, CA – \$9,597,117.00 (Base Bid)

\$60,697.00 (Add Alternate #01 – Replace Stabilized Decomposed Granite Paving with Artificial Turf) \$88,305.00 (Add Alternate #02B – With Bid Alternate 01 Acceptance, Furniture Installation to be in Artificial Turf area)

\$201,579.00 – (Add Alternate #03 – Basketball Court Plan & Basketball Court Striping per sheet BD3-1 & BD3-2)

Note: Total Contract Amount with all Added Alternates is \$9,947,698.00

Four (4) general contractors attended the mandatory job walk. One submitted a sealed bid.

The Uniform Public Construction Cost Accounting Act (the "Act") adopted on September 16, 2008 (BSA-23-08/09, Resolution No. 15-2008/09) provides an alternative method for public agencies to obtain bids and perform public projects. For projects of more than \$200,000, formal bidding procedures will be followed (PCC 22032(c)). If no bids are received, the District may negotiate a contract or use their own workforce. The award of contract and use of own workforce "force account" is still subject to approval by the Board of Trustees.

It is recommended that the Board of Trustees approve the contract to the lowest responsive bidder, Medallion Contracting, Inc.
