The scope of work (February 24, 2021) includes in-plant inspection of: (AWS CWI QCI) shop welding and fabrication, Moment Frames & Foundation Embeds, Wood Framing/Metal Stud, Electrical, Plumbing, Mechanical, Final Finish Inspection, Three (3) 72-feet x 40-feet relocatable buildings, Five (5) concrete pours. The site utility scope of work along with the AMS relocatable buildings will be a Division of the State Architect (DSA) approved project. A component of the inspection requirements is an "in-plant" inspection of the building during the off site fabrication process.
