#### **Comments from the Public:**

- 1. Noami Novak and Jay Vincelette of AYSO voiced their disappointment to learn United Street Park will not be watered for this years' soccer season.
- 2. Jeff Schank, RHS football coach invited the Board of Trustees and audience to attend the football games and support the team. First game is August 17<sup>th</sup>
- **3.** Mary Kluczkowski , CSEA-Paraeducator spoke against agenda item IX.B Resolution to reduce or eliminate classified positions.

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#### V. Reports and Communications

- **A.** Board Member Communications: **Gregg**-Glad to be back, looking forward to help move the district forward. Appreciates public comments. **Kirk**-Thanked audience for attendance to the meeting and comments and concerns. **Gutierrez** School starts very soon, we anticipate many changes. Glad to hear the public comments both negative and positive. Mr. Gutierrez agreed with Mr. Vincelette regarding the un-watered grass at United Street Park, it takes a long time to bring it back. **Sanchez**-Concurred with comments made by other board members. We need to do a better job notifying the public about changes.
- C. Superintendent: Interim Superintendent Leanne Hargus: Assured the staff and community the district is listening and hears their concerns as sensitive decisions are being made. Looking forward to working together to get through this budget reduction.
- **D.** KCSOS- Fiscal Advisor- J. Henderson: Mr. Henderson identified his role as support to the district administration. He outlined the support services provided by Kern County Superintendent of Schools to SKUSD. He stated KCSOS does not govern SKUSD but they must monitor all aspects of spending transactions. The county reviews the annual budget and an additional two years projected budget. Currently SKUSD is under a negative certification. Of the 1000 schools in California SKUSD is one of three with a negative certification. In lieu of the State taking control of the district, SKUSD Board of Trustees is working to manage budget reductions. The projected recovery date is July 2020 with high hopes to be July 2019. Mr. Henderson also stated the importance of keeping the community informed and requesting feedback from the staff, and community. He confirmed as the Fiscal Advisor he has "Stay and Resend" power over SKUSD and must use it as necessary. Mr. Henderson closed his communication by stating KCSOS is committed to see SKUSD back to solvency as soon as possible. Mr.

The Board thanked Mr. Henderson for his guidance and support from KCSOS. Mr. Henderson commended the Board of Trustees for their decision to work toward taking the necessary actions to bring the district back into a positive certification. The board can easily allow the State to take over SKUSD and make the cuts as the State sees fit to attain a "positive certification."
