- **B.** Child Nutrition: Summer Feeding Program- Director of Child Nutrition Andrea Andrews and Sodexo District Rep. Ben Montgomery reported on the Seamless Summer June and July statistics: Total meals served-3411, Breakfast-1302, Lunch-2109. The program is scheduled to expand over the school breaks including Thanksgiving, Winter break, and Spring break.
- **C.** School Site Showcasing: Westpark Elementary School: PLTW presentation by Ms. Canham and Mrs. Laurie Horton. They explained the tier structure of PLTW instruction and gave examples of the math and science connection for hands on learning.
