- During each module of Into Reading, students will be introduced to both irregular and decodable High Frequency words. At the start of each module you will receive a list of words that will be covered during class instruction.
- Irregular words are words that have some letters and sounds that can not be sounded out. (said = /s/ /e/ /d/)
- Your child will learn to refer to these as "heart" words, because there are parts students will need to learn by heart. Students will be taught strategies on how best to attack these words through program embedded routines.
- Decodable High Frequency words are the words that students can sound out, using phonics strategies taught during structured literacy routines. Ex: (at = /a / /t/)
