Module 10: Many Cultures, One World

In Module 10, students will continue learning various vowel teams including the Vowel Teams ew, ui, and ue that spell the $/\bar{u}/$ sound, Vowel Teams au, aw, and ough that spell the /aw/ sound, and Vowel Team ea that spells $/\bar{e}/$ sound. This module will wrap up with vowel a that spells the $/\bar{o}/$ sound.

Phonics Focus: Vowel Team ew, ui, ue as in $/\bar{u}/$

Grapheme	Rule	Examples		
ew	This is the Vowel Team ew. The letters e and w work together as a team to make one sound. The vowel team ew spells /ū/. The Vowel Team ew is found at the end of a word.	screw	few	stew
ui	This is the Vowel Team ui. The letters u and i work together as a team to make one sound. The vowel team ui spells $/\bar{u}/$. The Vowel Team ui is found in the middle of a word.	juice	fruit	suit
ue	This is the Vowel Team ue. The letters u and e work together as a team to make one sound. The vowel team ue spells $/\bar{u}/$. The Vowel Team ue is found at the end of a word.	glue	blue	clue

Phonics Focus: Vowel Team au, aw, ough as is /aw/

Grapheme	Rule	Examples		
au	This is the Vowel Team au. The letters a and u work together as a team to make the /aw/sound. The vowel team au is found in the middle or at the beginning of a word.	pause	audio	launch
aw	This is the Vowel Team aw. The letters a and w work together as a team to make the /aw/sound. The vowel team aw is usually found in the middle or at the end of a word but can also be found at the beginning.	saw	yawn	awesome AWESOME!
ough	This is the vowel team ough. The letters o, u, g, and h work together as a team to make the /aw/ sound. The vowel team aw is usually found in the middle of a word and is often followed by the letter t.	bought	thought	sought

Phonics Focus: Vowel Team ea as is $/\check{e}/$, Vowel a as in $/\check{o}/$

Grapheme	Rule	Examples		
ea	This is the vowel team ea. We already know this Vowel Team says /ē/, like in the word team. The Vowel Team ea can also spell /ĕ/, like in bread. The vowel team ea as /ĕ/ is not a common spelling pattern in words with the short e sound. It is only found in a few words. The most common sound-spelling for /ĕ/ is e.	bread	head	health
а	This is the vowel a. We already know this vowel says /ā/ and /ā/, like in the words apple and acorn. The vowel a can also spell /ŏ/, like in wash. Vowel a usually spells /ŏ/ when it follows consonant w, like in the words wash and want, and when it follows the letter combination qu, like in quad and squash. The vowel a as /ŏ/ is not a very common spelling pattern in words with the short o sound. The most common sound-spelling for /ŏ/ is o.	wash	watch	swamp


