Superintendent Jeff Weinstein and CBO Pete VanBuskirk explained in 2013, California adopted a new formula for deciding how much money each school district gets, called the Local Control Funding Formula (LCFF). The State Board of Education adopted regulations to implement the new LCFF. School districts will decide how to use the funds, but they must create a Local Control Accountability Plan (LCAP).
