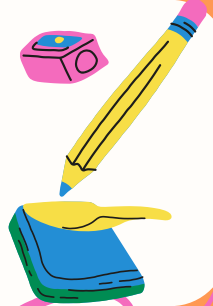

# SCHOOL SAFETY DRILL

## SEPTEMBER 18TH



Colene Hoose will be holding our school safety drill on Wednesday, September 18th at 9:00am. As a matter of teaching and learning how to respond to an emergency, each year we are to practice lockdown and evacuate with our first responder agencies in our Law Enforcement teams.

Below is the Unit 5 School Safety Drill Letter-

Hello Unit 5 Families,

Part of our mission to keep all of our stakeholders safe involves teaching best practices for responding to emergency situations. Over the past few years we have worked to strengthen these practices with our first responders throughout our area. Our school community has adopted and practiced the Standard Response Protocols by the ILoveUGuys Foundation. The standard response protocols are based on five actions that can be done to respond to all emergencies.

- HOLD - During a HOLD, students would stay in their classroom with the teacher and wait for an all-clear before moving to the next class. We might call a HOLD for a spill or other unsafe situation in the hallway.
- SECURE - We would call a SECURE if there was an unsafe event happening outside of the school. Exterior doors are all checked and students are not allowed to leave the building until it is safe.
- LOCKDOWN - A LOCKDOWN would be called if an extremely unsafe situation existed in the school. Students and staff would lockdown their classrooms until police could secure the building.
- EVACUATE - In the case of a fire, gas leak, or any other situations that make inside the building unsafe, we would EVACUATE the building using plans that are posted in each classroom.
- SHELTER - If weather conditions are unsafe, we would call a SHELTER which would cause students to move to the safest locations within our building.

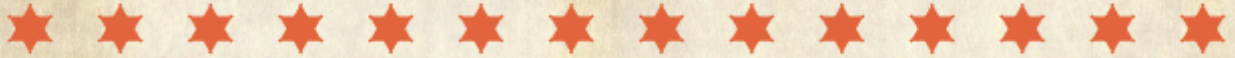

As a matter of teaching and learning how to respond in an emergency, each year the last three actions are practiced with our first responder agencies in our Law Enforcement and Fire Drills. Under the School Safety Drill Act, a law enforcement drill must be observed within the first 90 days of school. This year we will NOT be leaving campus to go to our reunification site at Eastview. If you would like to have your child opt out of this drill, please email me directly by Friday, September 13th.

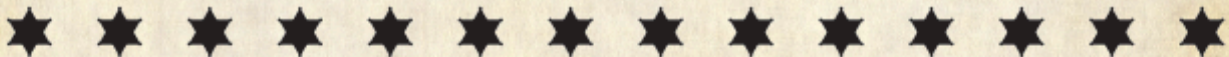

# PICK-UP & DROP-OFF REMINDERS



## Morning Drop-Off

- Drop-off starts at 7:25 and ends at 7:45am
- Please pull all the way forward to get as many cars in the drop off section as possible
- Once you get to the curb, please have your child ready to quickly get out of the car
- Student should get out on the curb side of the car only
- Parents, please stay in your cars as we need to keep the line moving
- Do not pass cars in the lane. Stay in one line throughout the drop off line
- Reminder that breakfast starts at 7:25, if your child needs breakfast please try to get here in enough time for them to finish before the start of the day at 7:45

## Afternoon Pick-Up

- Two pick-up lanes off of Grandview Drive
- Kindergarten pick-up starts at 2:25 and 1st-5th Grade pick-up starts at 2:30
- Families with the last name starting with A-L use pick up lane #1 (1st Turn)
- Families with the last name starting with M-Z use pick up lane #2 (2nd Turn)
- Parents need to stay in their car and wait in the car line, we need to ensure that the line keeps moving.
- If you need to assist your child with buckling, please pull past the loading zone and to the side.
- Please remind your child to be waiting in their grade level line outside watching for your car.
- Pick-up ends at 2:45
