### Safe Routes to School Survey Introduction - English

Dear Caregiver,

The City of San Mateo would like to learn your thoughts about students walking and biking to school. What would you like to see to make it safer and easier for students to walk, bike, roll or take the bus to school in San Mateo?

This <u>survey</u> will take about 5 minutes to complete. We ask that each family complete one survey per school your children attend.

Your responses will be kept confidential and neither your name nor your child's name will be associated with any results. Your input will help us build a city where all students can safely, confidently, and joyfully travel to and from school by biking, walking, rolling, or riding the bus, building healthy habits and community for all.

Walk, Bike, & Roll to School:



Join a group bike ride!

There are two group bike rides:

Meet at 7:50am at Hillsdale Mall Plaza (outside Philz)

OR

• Meet at 8:00am Hayward Park Caltrain Station parking lot

There will be optional after school rides following the same routes in reverse.

If walking or biking the whole way to school isn't an option for your family, consider parking a few blocks away to walk your students to campus. It's a great way to meet other families, reduce traffic, and encourage healthy habits.

# **Late Drop Offs:**

All students will have to walk on their own to their classroom if they arrive late to class (parents are not to walk to classrooms after the school day has started as this will interrupt the flow of classroom procedures).


The only exception to this is TK students, they may be walked to their class by parents if they arrive late. Kinder to 6th grade students should walk to their classrooms on their own.

# **School Absences:**

If you have any student out sick, not feeling well, your student will be late, or will be having a doctor's or dentist appointment please make sure you call our <u>main office at 650–312–7737</u>. After the 3rd day, if your student continues to be sick you will need to provide a doctors note to the office a week from the 3rd day missed. Please make sure you call <u>before 10:00am</u> on the day that your student will be absent and not the following day. If you don't notify us your student will be marked absent.

If your student is absent please make sure to bring a medical note as soon as the next day or when your student returns to school so that we may correct their attendance with enough time.
