PARTICIPATION IN EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

All students will participate in at least one extracurricular or co-curricular activity each year.

Provides students with a way to stay active and make new friends

Making the Grade

Number of students participating in at least one extracurricular or co-curricular activity.

100 Percent Student Participation = 50 Points

Variety of activity options available from the following categories: Athletics, Academic, Visual & Performing Arts, Service Leadership, and Avocation.

4 of 5 Categories = 30 Points

Number of teachers involved in supporting extracurricular and co-curricular activities.

100 Percent Teacher Participation = 20 Points



ACTIVITY REQUIREMENTS

Clubs/activities must be approved by the principal.

Students and teachers should have a choice in participating.

Students must be a member of a club/activity for at least nine consecutive weeks to get participation credit.

Clubs/activities should have a set meeting time, calendar of events, membership roster, and attendance sheets documenting participation.

Club/activity should sponsor at least one event that occurs outside of the set meeting time.



ACTIVITY REQUIREMENTS

Clubs/activities must be posted on your school website.

Club/activity must have student officers. (6th-12th grade only).

Clubs/activities should be fun and memorable.

Clubs/activities should help students feel connected to the school or part of a team.

Club/activities should engage participants in student-centered learning.



EXTACURRICULAR OPPORTUNITIES



Category	High School	Middle School	Elementary
Athletics	10	8	5
Visual & Performing Arts	10	8	5
Academics	10	8	5
Service & Leadership	7	5	3
Avocation	7	5	3

Must meet minimum activity requirement to receive credit for each category.

4-5 Categories = 30 Pts; 3 Categories = 20 Pts; 2 Categories = 10 Pts; 1 Category = 5 Pts

CATEGORIES DEFINED

Athletics – an organized sport that is sponsored by UIL and/or campus and provides students the opportunity to play on a competitive team with a fall and/or spring schedule of events. **EXAMPLES:** UIL Sports, Cheerleading, Intramural Sports, T-ball, Etc.

Academics – a program/organization that complements the academic curriculum and challenges students to demonstrate mastery of specific skills and knowledge while promoting one or more aspects of a field of study. **EXAMPLES:** Academic UIL, Chess, Debate, Yearbook, Etc.

Visual & Performing Arts – an organization/club that promotes visual and performing arts while providing students the opportunity to showcase their talents in the arts. **EXAMPLES:** Art Club, Ballet, Choir, School Play/Musical, Step Team, Etc.

Service & Leadership – an organization/club that advocates student leadership, volunteerism and scholarship while promoting community engagement and citizenship. **EXAMPLES:** 4-H Club, NHS, NJHS, PAL, Recycling Club, JROTC, HOSA, Etc.

Avocation – an organization/club that promotes hobbies outside of classroom work, particularly for pleasure or interest. **EXAMPLES:** Anime, Arts & Crafts, Board Games, Garden Clubs, Crochet, Etc.

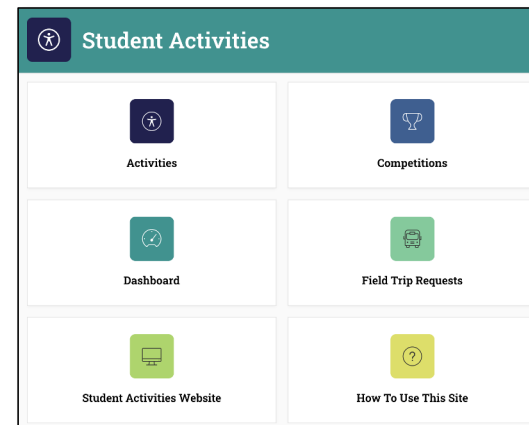

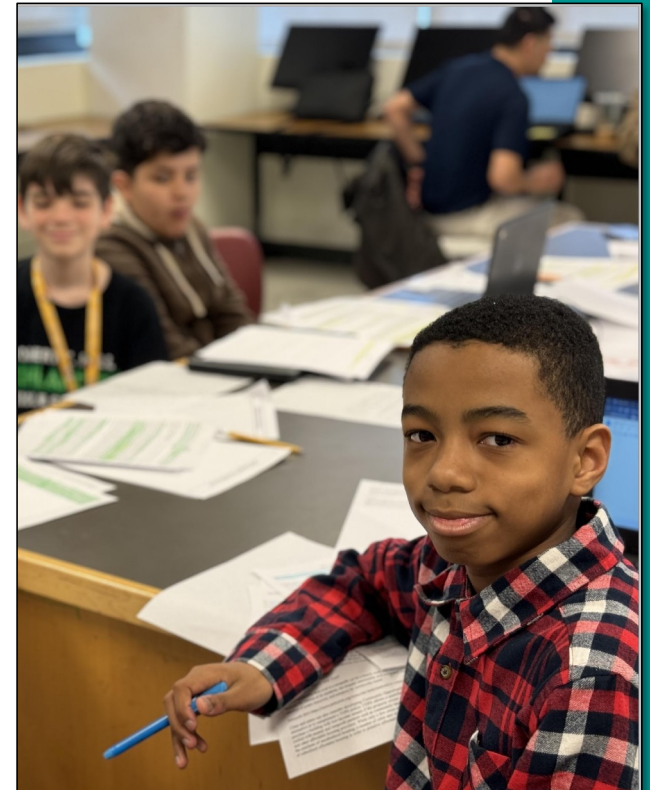
