Extracurricular Activity Requirements

- Clubs/activities must be approved by the principal.
- Students and teachers should have a choice in participating.
- Students must attend at least nine meeting sessions in the same club to get participation credit.
- Clubs/activities should have a set meeting time, calendar of events, membership roster, and attendance sheets documenting participation.
- Club/activity should sponsor at least one event that occurs outside of the set meeting time.
- Club/activity must be posted on your school website.
- Club/activity must have student officers. (6th - 12th Grade Only).
- Clubs/activities should be fun and memorable.
- Clubs/activities should help students feel connected to the school or part of a team.
- Clubs/activities should engage participants in student-centered learning.
