## KASD Goals

**Reading Goal:** With the use of small group interventions, they will maintain or increase individual student's Reading scores by at least one years grade level according to the MAPS Assessment.

**Math Goal:** With the use of small group interventions, they will maintain or increase individual student's Math scores by at least one years grade level according to the MAPS Assessment.



## Long Valley School Goals

**Reading:** To increase students' scores by providing instruction on the whole writing process including identifying the main idea and providing/citing details and evidence. Progress monitoring tools include Strategies for Writing program assessments, and MAPS assessments. Long Valley's goal is to have 60% of students at the proficiency level on Smarter Balanced Assessments.

**Math:** To maintain and increase student scores to 60% on indicator tests MAPS Benchmark Assessments with a focus on problem solving and data analysis.

**Attendance:** To achieve an attendance rate that exceeds our Kaskaskia Area District and SD state goal of 90%. Meeting this goal will help build **responsibility that lasts a lifetime!**
