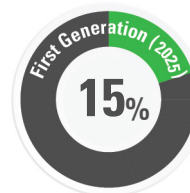
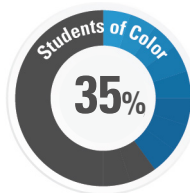

GRADING SCALE

In light of MUHS' selective admission policy and rigorous curriculum, the school does not rank its students.

- Semester grades reported on the transcript are unweighted.
- AP and dual enrollment courses are weighted, receiving 1.0 additional point per class.
- Both weighted and unweighted cumulative GPAs appear on the transcript.
- Highest Weighted GPA in Class of 2025 = 4.4
- Significant correlation between ACT and GPA data show sound and valid grading practices.

Every class at MUHS is a rigorous, college preparatory course. Academic rigor increases throughout a student's progression with Honors, Dual Enrollment, and AP Courses. MUHS offers 21 AP courses and 14 Honors courses. All MUHS courses are taken at MUHS and are taught by MUHS faculty. **Students can access AP course work beginning their sophomore year. Students are encouraged to take no more than three AP courses per year to promote balance and wellness.** The following are the highest level courses offered in each area:
