The Director of Mission Advancement will also work directly with the monks in support of the Abbey and their monastic way of life. The monks follow a simple and austere way of life that is marked by communal prayer, work, and fraternal charity. In their many years of service, they have provided support for the Academy as chaplains, teachers, department heads, director of dramatics and stage manager, and prayer partners. Saint Bede's most recent successful endeavors:

- concluded the first three phases of a \$15MM Legacy Campaign, resulting in the renovation and expansion of 23 teaching and learning spaces.
- exceeded the \$177,000 Fund-A-Need goal for new ADA compliant restrooms in the gymnasium.
- held the first annual St. Benedict's Day campaign on March 21, 2024, exceeding the \$170,000 goal by raising \$184,000 from 393 donors.
- enrolled 78 students in the Class of 2028, including boarding students from China, South Korea and from 20 local grade schools across Illinois.
- renovated St. Scholastica Dormitory to offer separate floors for boys and girls: St. Anne's Hall and St. John's Hall with double dorm rooms and a student lounge on each floor.
- partnered with Carus Corporation to host the 22nd annual Carus Science Camp, a free camp offered to area students entering the sixth grade.
 Since its inception in 2001, more than 625 students have taken part in this educational opportunity.
- offered summer camps for volleyball, basketball, wrestling, softball, and football for 300 students from the Illinois Valley.
- celebrated the 50th Anniversary of the Dedication of the St. Bede Abbey Church.

Building upon Saint Bede's long-standing reputation for excellence, the Director of Mission Advancement and Major Gifts will inspire and empower the Saint Bede community to actively and generously participate in philanthropic activities and student enrollment.







THE POSITION

Director of Mission Advancement and Major Gifts

Under the direction of the Superintendent and the Abbot, the Director of Mission Advancement and Major Gifts collaborates with the entire leadership team and manages all development systems and strategy to grow revenue, reputation and reach. The comprehensive responsibilities include identifying and leading coordinated activities that will engage people, grow enrollment, and raise funds in support of the mission of Saint Bede Abbey and Academy. The director is expected to advance the overall mission and vision of Saint Bede Abbey and Saint Bede Academy through cultivating and stewarding relationships with various constituents, and strategic leadership that reflects excellent communication, vision, integrity, impeccable moral character, and commitment to the institutional values.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities include, but are not limited to, the following:

- Manage a team that has four main focus areas: development, enrollment management, alumni relations, and marketing & communications.
 Foster collaboration, motivate and empower team members to achieve priorities and goals.
- Develop and implement an annual fundraising plan that includes: solicitation and stewardship of donors, all grants and funding applications, major donor engagement, individual fundraising, planned giving, and fundraising events.
- Personally solicit and close gifts from top donors and maintain relationships through mail, email, phone, and in-person contacts on behalf of Saint Bede.
- Coordinate the submission of grants and funding applications from Corporations, Foundations, and social organizations. Work with external grant resources to identify, prepare and submit grant applications. Responsible for tracking/reporting once received.
