High School Profile 2024-2025

- Centaurus High School offers a public comprehensive education for grades 9-12 with a staff of 75 and enrollment of approximately 1600 students.
- The 2023-2024 figures show 347 graduates, with 293 total students (84.4%) planning to enroll in higher education institutions—two or four year colleges or universities. Of those college bound students:
 - 238 graduates (68.6%) are attending four year colleges or universities
 - 55 graduates (15.86%) are attending two year community, junior colleges, or technical schools.
- The most recent information we have for our SAT scores comes from the Spring of 2024 school day testing. In April of 2024, 305 11th graders at CHS took the SAT test. The mean score for Centaurus High School was III4; mean ERW = 569, and mean math = 545. The mean total score for Boulder Valley School District was 1121, and the mean total score for the state of Colorado was 986.
- The College Board and ACT code number is 060-865.
- The Centaurus High School student ethnic mix is 1% African-American, 64% Caucasian, 26% Hispanic, .12% American Indian, 2.8% Asian, and 5% of students identify with 2 or more races.
- Approximately 30% of the student population at Centaurus is economically disadvantaged, qualifying for the Federal Free and Reduced Lunch Program.
- Centaurus High School hosts the district Newcomers Program. This program is for emerging bilingual language learners new to the United States in the last year, There are currently 59 students enrolled.
- The GRAD+ Framework is a BVSD initiative designed to increase postsecondary opportunities in both higher education and workplace arenas. Centaurus High School GRAD+ opportunities include 3 concurrent enrollment courses taught by a FRCC professor in a CHS classroom, 7 concurrent enrollment courses taught by FRCC credentialed CHS teachers in a CHS classroom, Seal of Biliteracy, work based learning, and industry certification support. During the 2023-24 school year, CHS students accomplished the following: 85 Seals of Biliteracy earned, 1017 concurrent or dual enrollment college credits completed, 30 work-based learning accolades awarded, and 289 industry certifications earned.

The Community and Students:

Lafayette is a growing community located in the rolling hills of Colorado's Front Range; I I miles east of Boulder and 20 miles north of Denver. Boulder County is noted as a university and research center with several large corporations and many high tech industries in the vicinity. The Boulder Valley School District encompasses 752 square miles of Boulder County including mountain, urban, and plains areas. The median household income in Lafayette is \$105,819, and 65.73% of residents in Lafayette are college educated.

4 Year Advisory Program:

Centaurus High School has a 4 year advisory program. Students meet with their advisory in a small class setting once per week. Centaurus is unique in that we incorporate the state-required ICAP requirements, along with critical skills into the advisory curriculum. Critical skills help to prepare students for life after high school through academic, personal and career-related lessons. The advisory class is worth 2.5 credits per semester and is worth an unweighted letter grade.

Programming at CHS

The teaching staff at Centaurus realizes the importance of a well-rounded education. Centaurus High School is an Engineering Focus School and an International Baccalaureate School that provides an environment rich in academia. Our International Baccalaureate. Advanced Placement, Engineering, AVID, elective, and extra-curricular programs ensure that each of our students is prepared for a competitive future. These programs provide students the most rigorous coursework in preparation for highly academic majors at the university level.





Advanced Programming at CHS

IB Program

- Centaurus' IB Diploma Program is a full diploma program of two years of study in the junior and senior years.
- Centaurus' IB Diploma students excel at the collegiate level due in part to the strengths they have cultivated through our IB program: they are critical thinkers. collaborators, and leaders. They are academically curious and resilient.
- Centaurus Graduates consistently earn the IB Diploma at a higher percentage than the world average. 2024 CHS IB Diploma earn rate was 94%, 14 percentage points above the world average.
- 15% of the CHS Class of 2024 IB Diploma Candidates are students of Hispanic ethnicity or multiple ethnicities; 100% of these students earned the IB
- 2024 CHS IB Graduates were awarded 6.3 million dollars in scholarships.
- There are currently 100 IB Diploma Candidates enrolled in the CHS IB Diploma program in 2024-2025.

AP Program

- In 2019, there are 782 AP course enrollments at Centaurus High School across the 14 available AP subjects.
- There are no limits to the number of AP classes a student can take. There are no applications, pre-requisites, or other barriers to students accessing the AP curriculum at CHS.

In 2019, 45 total Centaurus students earned an AP Scholar distinction:

- 16 AP scholars
- 15 AP scholars with Honor
- 13 AP Scholars with Distinction
- In the past 3 years, 5 students have been awarded National AP Scholar recognition.
- * At Centaurus High School, 67% of all AP exams taken earn scores of 3 or higher.

Engineering Program

 Centaurus Engineering students solve real world engineering problems in a creative, collaborative, and project based environment.

American Indian

- Over 475 students are currently enrolled in the program. Students design and build models using industry CAD software, and experiment with electronics and computer programming.
- The student laboratory is equipped with 3D printers, a laser engraver, two CNC machines, and a wind tunnel. Throughout their four years in the program, students connect with industry and academic partners in the classroom, on industry tours, through joint design projects, science fairs and expositions. Graduates pursuing careers in engineering are accepted to highly ranked four-year university engineering programs across the country.
