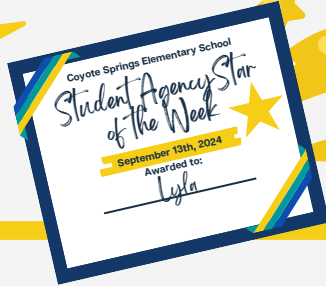

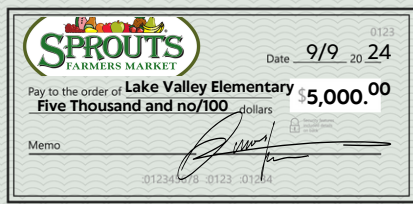

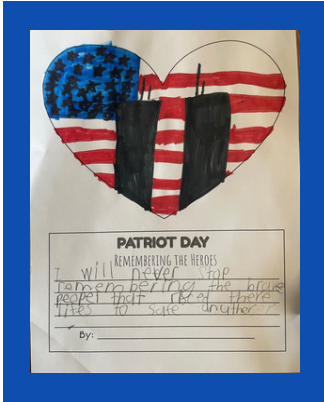
# BACK 2 SCHOOL DANCE



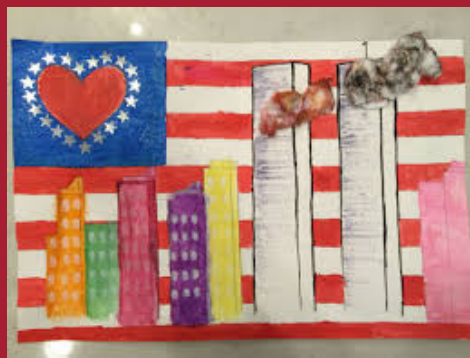

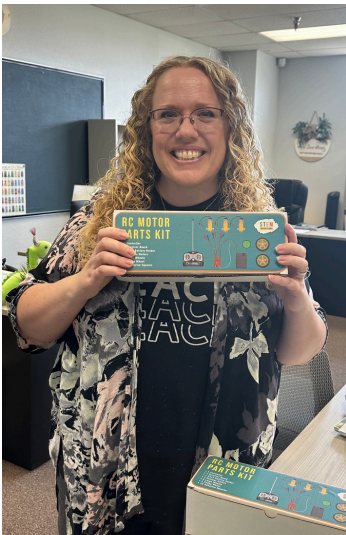
Thank you
