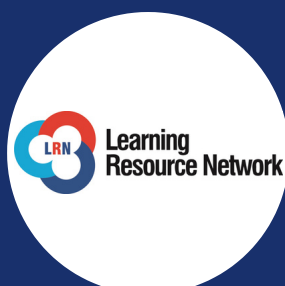

OxEd & Assessment (OxEd) is a University of Oxford spinout company launched to take the world leading research of Professor Charles Hulme's research group on early language and how children learn through to practical application in schools.

- LanguageScreen is an assessment tool to accurately assess oral language skills in children aged 3.5-11. It enables schools to measure and track the progress of pupils' language skills and identify those who would benefit from interventions or specialist support. The assessment measures up-to-four tests of fundamental language skills: Expressive Vocabulary, Receptive Vocabulary, Listening Comprehension and Sentence Repetition, and scores are combined to provide an age-standardised measure of the child's overall language ability. Assessments take less than ten-minutes per student and can be administered by any member of school staff.
- ReadingScreen is a quick and accurate digital assessment of word and nonword reading. It can be administered by any adult, taking 2-10 minutes per child and will identify children requiring extra support to develop decoding skills.
- When a child is assessed with both LanguageScreen and ReadingScreen the results are automatically plotted on a graph representing the Simple View of Reading to identify the nature and extent of any possible language or reading difficulties. This clearly highlights whether students have problems with decoding, comprehension or both so you can easily see what kind of additional support the children in your class may need.
