## **DRAFT MINUTES CURRICULUM SUB-COMMITTEE**

**Called to order at 9:00.** Members present were Jessee Clements, Lisa Dix, Maureen Fuller, Dr. Maguire, Kathleen Quintal, Keri Scoffield, Dr. Starkie, Dr. Zhou.

1. Minutes of 6-5-24 were approved.
2. [Summer Enrichment Review](#): Three successful programs ran this summer. Lisa Greene taught K Readiness at BES for 11 students; Jennifer Ward taught Amazing Me at BES for 13 students, and Rebecca Salgado taught Musical Theater at BMS for 22 students with a culminating performance at BES and for the community.
3. [PD Overview](#): Full Day of PD on the first teacher day back to school was very well received. The morning offered a variety of over 20 technology workshops with the theme “Making Connections.” Teachers had to attend 1 designated workshop and could choose 3 elective workshops. The workshops were led by experts from the outside and experts from our own staff. The afternoon featured Pam Garramone who spoke about keeping happy and generating and sustaining positivity. Out of this afternoon came the “Happiness Challenge”! The 11.5 PD will welcome back Kalise Warnum as our Key Note speaker speaking about inclusive practices. Staff will attend SEED training and have a variety of speakers to choose from.
4. [Proposed Yoga Instructional Book](#): The subcommittee unanimously approved a yoga book called *Science of Yoga* which will be used in our Health & Wellness class to upper classmen as a full year elective.
5. Happy Numbers: Happy Numbers is a math digital curriculum which was piloted in grades K-5 last April thru June. It will take the place of Imagine Math and also offers differentiated printables and games. Recommended use is between 30-40 minutes/week.
6. [EdPuzzle](#): Ed Puzzle is a library of video explainers which are linked to instruction. It is available to the entire district and is currently very popular at the secondary level.
