Math: At the end of the 2025 school year, we will see a 3% increase in the percentage of students who are proficient and above on Georgia Milestone assessments from the 2024 results. (End of Grade of 3rd-8th and End of Course in 9th grade Algebra 1 combined)

Reading/ELA: At the end of the 2025 school year, we will see a 3% increase in the percentage of students who are proficient and above on Georgia Milestone ELA assessments from the 2024 results. (End of Grade in 3rd-8th End of Course in 11th grade English Literature and Composition combined)
