HOLIDAYS SEASON REMINDER

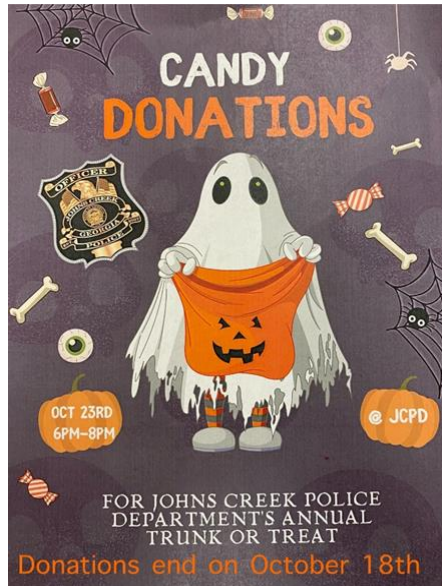

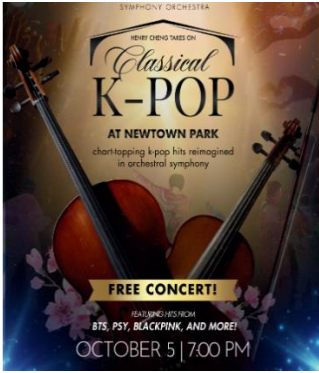
